PARENT PLACEMENT REQUESTS

Dear Parents or Guardians:

We are now ready to place your incoming TK/K and current TK/K-Fourth grade students in classes for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year. The teachers and the principal will be putting class lists together very soon; therefore, we are opening an abbreviated window for parents to fill out and return the Parent/Child Information placement forms. **The Parent/Child Information placement forms will be available to pick up by PARENTS ONLY in the elementary school office on** <u>Monday, May 6th</u> and need to be turned into the office by <u>Thursday, May 9th by 3:30</u>. Any turned in after that date will not be reviewed.

It is important to realize that placement decisions are the responsibility of the principal, and that the highest priority considered in making placement decisions is the academic needs of your child as identified by his or her teacher. Also, it is important to remember that many other factors influence these decisions. These factors include: consideration for the social needs of the child, class size, and the need to maintain a balanced group.

Teacher staffing may change due to further unforeseen revisions this summer. The teacher you request may not be at the grade level you request. Your child's class placement will be posted in Aeries the week prior to school starting.

Celebrates Cottonwood Rodeo with a Pancake Breakfast and dress up day! May IOth


Dress like a cowboy/cowgirl!
