Lost and Found

Planned Vacations

Student Absences

The state auditor requires documentation of all student absences. Your family can assist us by calling the school (530-347-3411) if your child is ill or unable to attend school early the morning of their absence or the evening before. We have an answering machine from 4:00pm to 7:30am. When you leave an attendance message on the answering machine, please leave your child's first and last name, the name of your child's teacher and the reason for the absence. You may also email eattendant@evergreenusd.org

Unverified absences are unexcused. If your child has three unexcused absences, leave early, and /or tardies, he/she will be considered truant.

Art to Remember

School Accountability Report Card

Annually, on February 1st, each school within the Evergreen Union School District is required to write and provide a School Accountability Report Card (SARC) for the public, sharing the prior year's data. The SARC contains information about the District and our specific school site regarding student achievement, enrollment, resources our schools provide, demographics, and even the maintenance of our campuses. 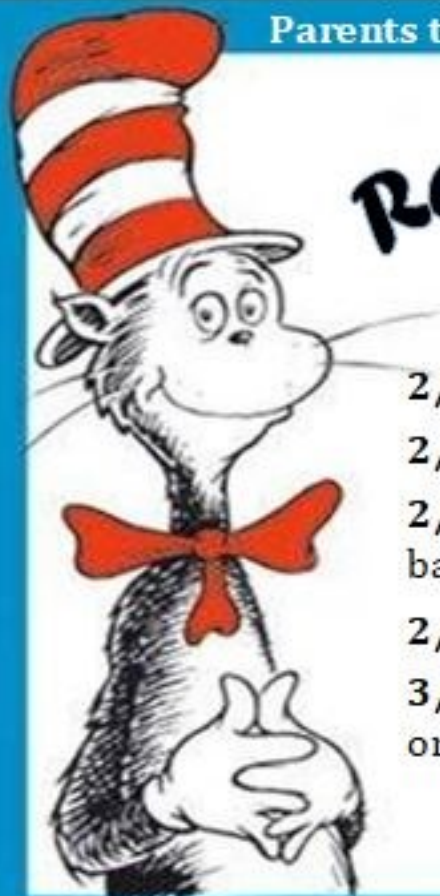

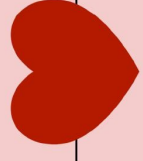
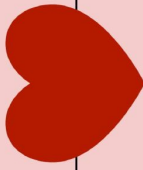
