Planned Vacations

Student Absences

The state auditor requires documentation of all student absences. Your family can assist us by calling the school (530-347-3411) if your child is ill or unable to attend school early the morning of their absence or the evening before. We have an answering machine from 4:00pm to 7:30am. When you leave an attendance message on the answering machine, please leave your child's first and last name, the name of your child's teacher and the reason for the absence. Unverified absences are unexcused. If your child has three unexcused absences, leave early, and / or tardies, he/she will be considered truant.

Perfect Attendance for the 2nd Trimester

On Thursday 3/28/24 we celebrated 54 students who had perfect attendance for the second trimester!

Attendance is so important that studies show that missing 10% of school can make it harder to gain early reading and math skills, build relationships and graduation rates drop about 16% for chronically absent students.

Council Membership Election

Evergreen Elementary site council is comprised of parents, teachers, and administration. They meet once a month to review and make recommendations to the Evergreen Union School District's Board concerning special program budgets and educational programs.

There are TWO parent positions up for election for the 2024-2026 school years. The nomination period starts April 29th and ends on May 3, 2024. Nomination ballots are available in the elementary school office.

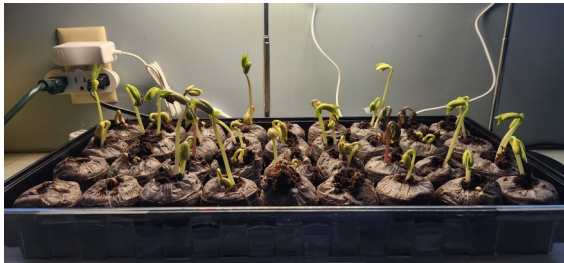
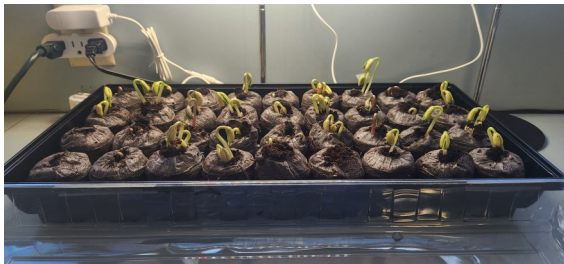

From planting tiny seeds to watching them reach for the sun, each day is a new adventure in their classroom garden. Through this hands-on experience, students are not only learning about the life cycle of plants but also discovering the vibrant hues nature has to offer.



First Grade News

In first grade, we are wrapping up our observing the sky unit. We have been learning about the sun, moon, and stars. The students have also been learning about constellations and the phases of the moon. Next, we will be diving into ponds (not really, haha). We will learn about the life cycle of frogs and other pond animals and insects. There will be real life observations of the frog life cycle, as many of the 1st grade classrooms will have tadpoles, so the students can see the frog life cycle in action. Ribbit! Ribbit!



Fourth Grade News

Fourth Grade Rocks! This month fourth graders have centered their learning on geology. They are learning about earthquakes and earthquake safety, volcanoes, the 3 categories of rocks, and fossils. A field trip to Gaumer's Mineral and Mining Museum in Red Bluff sparked their interest in gems and minerals. Many bought some geological treasures of their own to bring home. Another field trip to Lake Shasta Caverns took them deep underground to reveal the secrets of limestone cave formations: stalactites and stalagmites. Crystals are being grown in the classroom to demonstrate how crystals form when water evaporates. We are finishing reading The Mystery on the California Mission Trail, our literature book to coincide with learning about the Spanish Mission Era in California. Students also individually wrote a report about a mission. A great learning experience would be visiting one of the 21 missions in California if you are out traveling about this vacation.

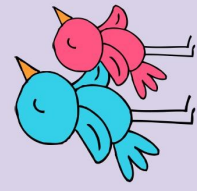
